I understand, that in order to be eligible for a Miss Vermont Preliminary Title:

I must be 17 –24 years old, turn 18 by June 30, 2012 and have graduated from high school by June 30, 2012.

I must compete in the 2011 Miss Vermont Scholarship Competition, June 30, 2012.

Participants of the Preliminary Titleholder Program may not compete in any other pageant or similar competition while holding a Miss Vermont Preliminary Title.

Each contestant participating in the Preliminary Title Program is required to pay the development program fee of \$250 and will be able to choose a title on a first-come, first served basis. You can pay the \$250 fee in full, or opt for a three month payment plan.

If you choose the payment plan, a minimum non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due at commitment, with \$100 due the second month and \$100 due the final month.

If you choose to attend a development workshop before you are paid in full you must pay the \$25 skill building workshop fee, but it will count towards the total \$250 payment for the Preliminary Title Program.

All fees paid towards your participation in the Preliminary Titleholder Program, Development Workshops, or the 2012 Scholarship Competition are non-refundable.

By signing this Application & Contract and submitting it to the Miss Vermont Scholarship Organization for approval, the Contestant and their Parent/Guardian agrees that (1) all facts and representations contained in this Application and Contract are true and accurate; (2) the Contestant agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Miss Vermont Scholarship Organization as described in this Application and Contract, as well as the Code of Conduct; (3) that the Contestant's name and photograph may appear on the MVSO web site, www.missvermont.org, and promotional materials.
